Hands brush over hers, as the bride's mother adjusts her bangles and her sister fastens the haaram. Her heart beats a little faster, a mix of nerves and joy, as each piece falls into place. The vaddanam doesn't just hold her drape, it cinches generations of stories.

As cumin and jaggery sweeten the air and the thaali chain rests against her collarbone, a hush falls, broken only by smiles, glances exchanged and the quiet weight of forever settling in.
